From Church Extension Ministries



During the month of November, we were blessed with a visit from David Gundrum, director of Church Extension Ministries. As you may recall, Church Extension Ministries focuses on planting new Bible Fellowship churches, helping them develop until they become fully self-supporting. Please read this update concerning their December giving project.

Every year during the month of December, Church Extension holds its second major fund raiser, Christmas Gift Month. Incorporated with Christmas Gift Month, we have a "Matching Gift" challenge. We have several donors who provide a total of \$50,000.00 if we can raise at least 100 gifts of \$500.00 or more. Please pray for this matching gift to be confirmed this week. We are still in need of one donor to provide \$5,000 to \$10,000 for the matching gift. However, we are moving ahead with all the preparations for the matching gift and trusting God to provide this last matching gift donor.

The Christmas Gift Month fundraiser is very important. We first use this money to catch up our budget (currently we are behind in budget by \$25,000.) We then use the funds to make sure your Planters that have deficits in their support are fully paid for the year. (Current deficits total \$70,000.) Finally, we use the funds to open the New Year with a needed cash flow to pay the planters and work with the needs of the plants. (We will be helping those church plants who need new facilities and those graduating in 2023.)

Our goal this year is higher than in years past. This year we are asking the Lord to provide \$200,000.00 through our churches and partners. We realize this is going to be a challenge in light of the current economy; however, we know that the Lord wants us to reach people with the Gospel and plant churches that will make disciples. This Mission is a vital Kingdom building work for the Lord, and we trust He will bless.

Will you please pray for Christmas Gift Month and pray that the Lord will help us reach our goal? Will you help us with your gift? Thank you, and many blessings.
